

# Vinyl Flooring

## Pros

- Simplest of all for installation (taps together with rubber mallet)
- More stable with less movement than other vinyl flooring types. The ABS plastic frame expands at a different rate than the vinyl top skin so the two tend to cancel each other out
- 100% waterproof
- No underlay required
- IIC 73 rated for low sound transmission
- Has slightly cushioned feel underfoot unmatched by thinner vinyl's
- Airspace underneath the top layer acts as an insulator. Feels less cold underfoot than thinner vinyl's
- Can be easily pulled apart using a plunger if plank needs to be replaced

## Cons

- Because of its thickness baseboards need to be raised, doors may need to be trimmed and jambs must be undercut
- Airspace between the top layer and subfloor acts as an insulator therefore making it unsuitable for radiant in floor heat systems
